Exclusion Due To Health Conditions

Environmental Health Guide

Each client is to be advised that solarium use should be avoided if they have certain health conditions.

Every client should be made aware that if they have any of the following conditions sun tanning should be avoided. Operators can advise clients who have the following conditions to consult their doctor prior to using the solarium unit.

Health Conditions for Exclusion

- Pregnancy
- Asthmatics
- Back problems
- Diabetes
- Heart conditions - including pacemakers
- Cold sores
- Migraine
- Epilepsy
- Allergies
- Eye infections
- Blood pressure
- Giddiness/fainting
- Kidney/urinary problems
- Hyperaction of the thyroid gland
- Open wounds

The use of solariums for therapeutic purposes as directed by a medical practitioner is not covered by AS/NZS 2635:2002 but it is recommended that a referral from the client's medical practitioner is sought before allowing the client to use the sun tanning unit.

“Sun tanning inside is as harmful as outside.”

The above information is not contained in the AS/NZS2635:2002. However solarium operators should inform clients of this health information.
