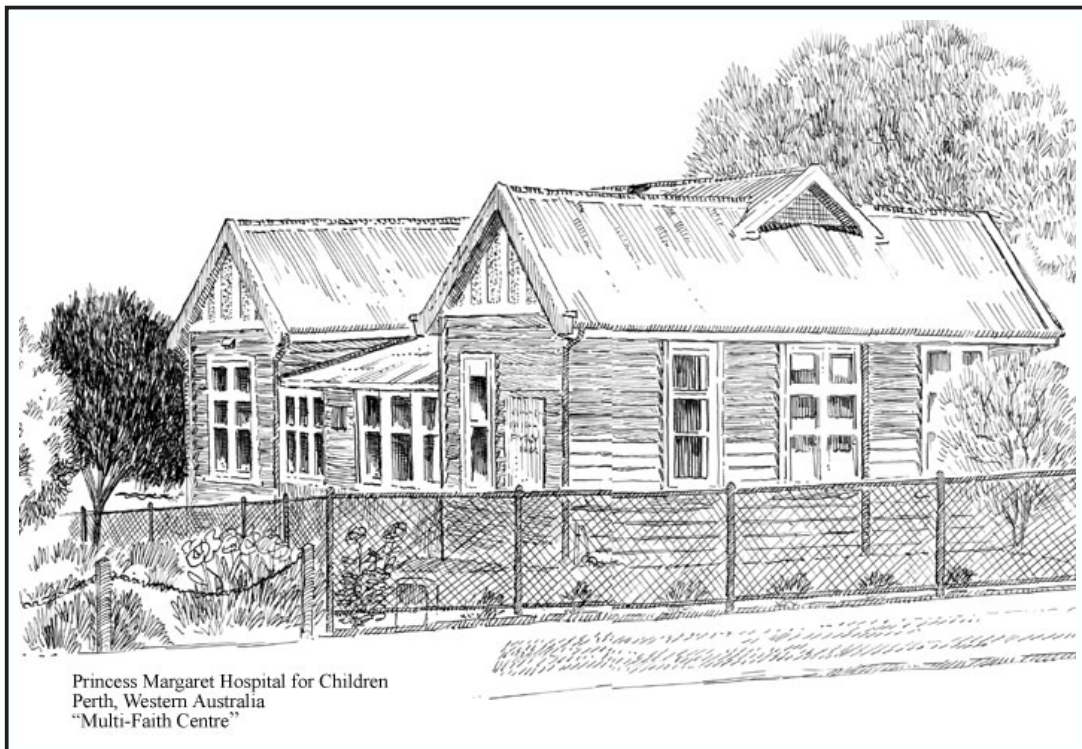


# Pastoral Care Services Chaplaincy at PMH



## **Chaplains:**

- take care of religious, spiritual and pastoral needs;
- are members of PMH's health care team;
- care for patients, their families and carers;
- visit people of all faiths and religions;
- will contact your own religious representative at your request;
- can be contacted for specific religious services such as prayer, baptism and communion;
- are available to discuss ethical questions relating to you and your child;
- can provide pastoral counselling.

## **Multi-faith Centre**

In the Multi-faith Centre you will find the

- Chapel
- Salat [Muslim Prayer] Room
- Quiet Room

The chaplains' offices are also located in this building.

The Centre occupies the historical weatherboard building (pictured on the front of this brochure) on the corner of Thomas and Hay Streets, Subiaco.

It is open during daylight hours. After hours please ask your nurse to contact security who will escort you there.

## Come and visit

The Multi-faith Centre is a good place to take 'time out' from the Wards.

It is quiet, and you can sit comfortably to rest, read or pray.

There is a telephone in the Quiet Room so you can phone the Ward, or your nurse can contact you - extension 8920.

To ask for a chaplain, contact the switchboard by dialling '9' on this phone.

On the altar in the chapel is a book in which you can write prayers you wish to share.

## How to contact us

Chaplains are available 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week.

If you would like to speak to a chaplain

- ask your nurse,
- phone the switchboard on '9' on hospital phones or ring 9340 8222, or
- contact extension 8670 during office hours.
